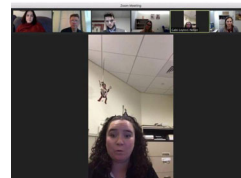
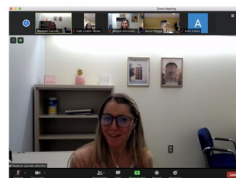
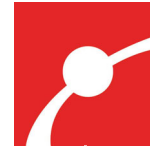

From July 2021 through December 2021, Triangle has provided Pre-ETS to 95 students. Students have taken advantage of over 1000 hours of support across the five components: Job Exploration Counseling, Work Readiness Training, Work-Based Learning Experiences, Counseling in Post-Secondary Education, and Self-Advocacy Training. Included under the Work-Based Learning Experience category are paid internships which students have participated in over 550 hours.

Students learned about the Museum of Science as an employer for the Greater Boston Area. Game Design Event

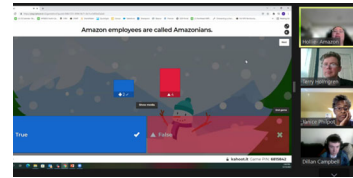
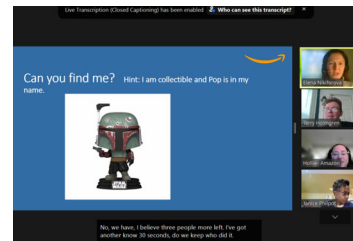
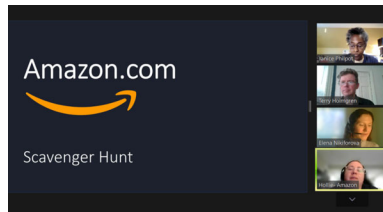
