#### **UPDATE FROM RACHEL KAPRIELIAN, CEO**

The past year at Triangle has been marked by tremendous achievements by the individuals we serve. Across our day programs, residential homes, workforce development initiatives, and enrichment services for school and community partners, we have remained steadfast in our mission to empower people with disabilities and their families to live rich, fulfilling lives.

Our legacy programs—longstanding pillars of Triangle—continue to thrive as part of our Five-Year Strategic Plan. Since 2022, we have added two new residential homes and increased enrollment across our legacy day services sites by 26%. At the same time, we have launched innovative service models and opened new program sites that will expand our capacity to serve an additional 60 young adults with disabilities in the coming years.

As we look ahead to the final two years of our growth plan, we remain focused on our four core tenets: Community, Employment, Empowerment, and Independence. These principles will guide us as we strengthen and enrich our existing programming while developing new models that respond to the evolving needs of the younger generation entering our services.

We give our heartfelt thanks to everyone who contributes to the success of our program participants—families, employment partners, community organizations, corporate champions, board members, school districts, disability advocacy groups, fellow service providers, and our state funding agencies. Together, we positively impacted the lives of 2,700+ members of the Massachusetts disability community in the past year alone.

As we look toward 2026, we are excited to continue growing Triangle's impact across the Commonwealth.
